It is with deep frustration and disappointment in Jefferson County's recent decision to fire Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport Director Paul Anslow that we, the undersigned Advisory Board Members, tender our immediate and full resignation.

The Advisory Board has worked closely with Director Anslow and his staff over the past several years to refresh and revitalize the airport's master and strategic plans and then systematically implement changes for the benefit of the airport stakeholders and Jefferson County. The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners has taken an action that has all the hallmarks of political maneuvering rather than thoughtful and impartial management of a valuable county resource in RMMA.

In our collective opinion, Director Anslow was a passionate, dedicated and hard-working leader for the airport, the community, and the airport stakeholders. Under Director Anslow's leadership, the airport is growing, financially stable, and is attractive to a variety of aviation enterprises and individual aircraft owners. This was not the case prior to his appointment. Director Anslow was instrumental in successfully advancing the airport's and, by extension, Jefferson County's interests.

It has been an honor to serve on the Airport Advisory Board as each of us is dedicated to the airport's current and future success. We are proud of the hard work performed and progress made to benefit the airport and Jefferson County. It is regrettable that our service will now end under such distasteful circumstances.
